

#### **METHODOLOGY**


The following survey was conducted nationwide by OnMessage Public Strategies. Text-to-web interviews were conducted on June 18-25, 2024.


This survey consists of 1,000 likely voters and was stratified to reflect historical turnout. The margin of error for this survey is +/- 3.1%.









If the 2024 general election for President were held today and the candidates were Donald Trump, a Republican, Joe Biden, a Democrat, for whom would you vote?



Thinking about policy priorities for Congress, would you be more or less likely to support your elected officials in Congress if they prioritized securing the southern border?






# FINANCIAL BURDEN OF ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION

"We should secure the southern border so that the federal government no longer has to carry the financial burden of mass illegal immigration."






### END THE CRISIS

Thinking again about illegal immigration and our southern border, please tell me if you agree or disagree with the following statement:



Thinking once more about illegal immigration and our southern border, how concerned are you about the border crisis driving up federal spending and draining resources?


















## EXTENDING TCJA IMPACT








## CUTTING WASTE IMPACT






### GOVERNMENT IS TOO BIG



Would you support or oppose a federal law that requires more transparency on how agencies spend your tax money, so that any American taxpayer could go online and see how every agency spends its money?







"Congress should limit the size and scope of federal agencies, so government bureaucrats have less involvement in Americans' daily lives."







As you also may know, interest payments on the national debt are now higher than federal spending on national debt. With this in mind, please tell me if you agree or disagree with the following statement:

"Congress needs a plan to address the debt that is realistic and can be enacted into law in short order."








